Thoughts on Lent....

Lent can be experienced as a serious season. Sacrifice, denial, and confession are the focus of the Lenten season and these are things we value but we don't often celebrate. While we understand the importance of them, they do not elicit the joyous emotions of Christmas. I heard a pastor say once: that Hallmark does not sell any Lent greeting cards. They sell cards for every other major holiday. This is to say- we don't enjoy celebrating Lent.

What if you could celebrate Lent? Sacrifice is difficult but when we give up something, whether it be food, action, or items it leaves space. Time, money, and energy freed up.
